

Your route to the **labour market**.

Find training. Secure a job.

We help you find an apprenticeship or a job. Or to stay in your job. Even when things get difficult: Because you might be struggling physically or emotionally. Or because you might have some limitations. With youth work assistance you have experienced advisors on your side to help you with all of this, including when it comes to contact with businesses and authorities. For more job security: **Youth work assistance**.

Who is youth work **assistance** for?

"I want a job that is right for me. And I want the business to value my work".

Youth work assistants help with the search for apprenticeships and jobs and, at your request, mediate between you, your colleagues and the company if there is a problem at your place of work. They also help companies to recruit suitable apprentices and employees. They can advise on internal requirements and funding opportunities.

How youth work **assistance** helps you.

Whether it is an apprenticeship, a job, or an internship: Youth work assistance helps you to find a job or to stay in a job even under difficult circumstances.

Finding a job/apprenticeship: Your advisor will discuss how best to approach the labour market. You will get help with applications and interview preparation. There is also support for organising internships or work trials.

Starting a job: In the first few months of a new job or apprenticeship there can be a lot of challenges. The work assistance service supports you during this period.

Keeping the job: Are you struggling with your job or training? With expectations? With superiors? With colleagues? Your advisor can mediate between you and other parties involved to find a satisfactory solution.



Important points:

- For adolescents from the 9th school year (up to 25th birthday) with support needs or socio-emotional impairments and/or disabilities.
- Youth work assistance is free and voluntary.
- Youth work assistance is available for up to one year.
