Are you worried about coping with your apprenticeship or job? Because you are restricted by your health? Or because you have a disability?

Job coaches support you in securing sustainable employment. They accompany you to your place of work and work with you, colleagues and superiors to find strategies and solutions so that you can stay in your job long term. **For more job stability: Job coaching.**

How job coaching helps.

“Things are constantly changing at work: What I’m supposed to do, or how I’m supposed to do it. How can I manage that?”

Job coaches can help you **in the workplace**. They work with you to make your time at work easier and more successful.

And **companies benefit as well**, as they receive useful information on accessibility, funding opportunities and legal framework conditions.

What job coaching does practically.

Job coaching helps you through consultations and practical assistance directly at your company.

Arrival: Job coaches support you during onboarding, internships or if you are returning to work after a long period of sickness.

Adjustment: Job coaches help with a better understanding of what requirements you need for your work. This may be technical equipment, changes to working times or adjustments to processes.

Advice: Job coaches offer advice on work-relevant topics. Coaching is personal and confidential.

Support: Is the commute to your place of work a challenge? Job coaches accompany you on your journey until you have sufficient confidence. They can also help you prepare for your driving test if a license is required for work purposes.



Important points:

- Job coaching is free and voluntary.
- For adults with beneficiary status or a disability level of $\geq 30\%$.
- For adolescents from the 9th school year until their 25th birthday with special educational or support needs.
- Job coaching can be accessed for up to 6 months.
