

# Inclusion creates the future.

For at-risk adolescents, people with disabilities, and businesses.

**What is NEBA?** The acronym NEBA stands for “Netzwerk Berufliche Assistenz” (“Occupational assistance network”). This network offers support for choosing a profession, finding a training or a job, as well as for applying for and securing work for:

- at-risk adolescents,
- people with disabilities and/or special educational needs and
- businesses who want to contribute to an inclusive labour market.

There are **six NEBA offers** available. They are provided by various organisations throughout Austria and are free for participants and companies.

## The NEBA offer at a glance

### ■ Youth coaching

Youth coaching helps young people with **career guidance**. Special support is provided to adolescents who have dropped out of school or want to drop out or who are unable to complete compulsory schooling successfully.

### ■ AusbildungsFit

AusbildungsFit can also be used after youth coaching. This **structured daily program** allows young people who are not attending school or vocational training to catch up on important social skills and any missed basic qualifications. The **preparatory module** can help you get started.

### ■ Vocational training assistance

Vocational training assistance supports people during an **extended apprenticeship** or **partial qualification**. Support is available for trainees, businesses and vocational schools.

### ■ Work assistance

Work assistance supports people with disabilities, chronic diseases and limitations as well as adolescents who require assistance to **find a job**, with **training** or with **securing long-term employment**.

## ■ Job coaching

Job coaching supports and helps people with disabilities and adolescents requiring assistance **directly at the place of work**. The aim is to help those with support requirements with their working life. Job coaches can also help with the commute.

## ■ Business service

The business service **offers companies advise on work and disability**. They offer information about legal framework conditions, funding, employment opportunities, accessibility and the benefits of employing people with disabilities or those requiring assistance. It opens up valuable potential in times of digitalisation and skills shortages.
